Some of my faculty advisor's information was outdated and no longer used. However, by staying consistent and calling the school's to request their clubs information, I was able to recreate my division's contact list and instantly saw an increase in the responses. This led to increase in DCM and project participation, and a greater impact on our community. This is when I knew that I wanted to run for Sec/Tres; I wanted LTGs across the district to see this same reaction.

I would work closely with LTGs and individual clubs to create a cohesive District Directory early on that would allow us to have as many connections with a club as possible. I have seen how important having these student leaders contacts in addition to advisors is. Having multiple points of contact in a club means more people receiving our information and a higher chance that this information will be shared with our clubs!

When thinking about what I will do as Secretary and Treasurer, I hope to bring the unity I was able to create to district level. I would add a section to the club reports asking clubs if they shared their newsletter with their members so we can ensure at least the most vital information is being sent to members. This small box would serve as a crucial reminder while taking no more of the officer's time. To expand on my work in the K-Fam committee, I wish to create more accessible and easy to understand resources on how to form new Key Clubs. This would be part of my duty of assisting clubs in processing dues, including our new clubs in having easy access to all the information they need. I would also create cohesive guides on how to pay dues and open my doors for all of those in need of additional assistance.

Through my position I hope to be an instrument of change within our division, bettering our ability to achieve Key Club's motto: "Caring- our way of life". The Capital District is a blooming district full of opportunity, and I believe with my experience and developed plans we will continue to become stronger.
